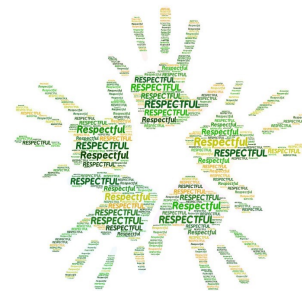

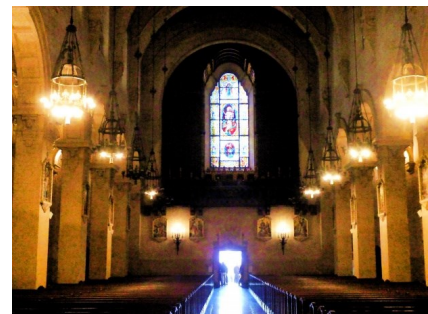
Dear God
